

Sharing Your Medical Information

Sharing your GP medical record with other NHS professionals and organisations

Improving your care through the appropriate sharing of information

GP surgeries in Barnet are now able to share patient information. We are also working collaboratively with our local hospitals, community services and local "out of hours" providers to enable them to see your GP medical records.

This means that key areas of your medical record may be made available to NHS healthcare professionals who will be responsible for your care if you are referred to services outside of your GP surgery.

Your information will only be accessed by trained staff. Sharing this information will improve the quality of care you receive, when you need NHS treatment outside of the surgery, but the choice to share this information is yours. Sharing of your GP medical record will avoid unnecessary appointments and tests, and in turn will improve the care you receive.

Please be assured that no one outside of this practice will access your records without your verbal consent each time you are seen.
